STORAGE:

- Store at room temperature.

- Do not cover the affected area(s) with any kind of bandage, tape, plastic wrap or anything similar unless advised by your doctor.
- To limit exposure to others in household; children, partner, and pets should avoid contact with unwashed or unclothed application sites.
